DESCRIPTION OF THE PROGRAMMING

The McCord Stewart Museum is offering two alternating themes for day camps during the summer of 2023. During your visit to the Museum, the children will discover an exhibition and do an activity around it.

Theme 1: Becoming Montreal – The 1800s Painted by Duncan

Inspired by the old paintings and digital artworks they will discover in the exhibition <u>Becoming Montreal – The</u> <u>1800s Painted by Duncan</u>, young people will be invited to activate their own imagination!

Theme 2: Hochelaga – Evolving Montreal

Children will discover the playful and colourful universe of artist <u>Joannie Lafrenière</u>. The visit will highlight the contemporary photos in the exhibition <u>Hochelaga – Evolving Montreal</u> and a workshop will lead the children to explore their own creativity!
