- School visits include a workshop as part of the base rate. An additional fee applies for any extra guided activities.
- Admission is free for Indigenous individuals and community groups.

Reservations

- All reservations must be made online through [McCord Museum - Group Booking](#).
- Requests must be submitted **at least three weeks** before the date you wish to visit. No changes can be made to requests submitted after this deadline.
- A confirmation email will be sent with all the necessary **documents to help you prepare** for your visit or activity.

Payment

- You will receive an invoice after your visit. Payment can be made by cheque, credit card or Interac transfer.
- Any applicable **banking fees are the responsibility of the client**.
- We do not accept payment on site.

Cancelling or Modifying a Reservation

- Cancellations are free of charge if made at least **two weeks** before the scheduled visit. It is not possible to cancel after this deadline, and the reservation will be invoiced in full.
- Any changes to a reservation are **subject to availability** and must be requested by **email at least two weeks** before the new date you wish to visit. Requests made after this deadline will be handled on a case-by-case basis depending on availability.
- You will receive a confirmation email if your requested change is accepted. Only the confirmation email serves as proof that the change was approved.

INFORMATION ON VIRTUAL ACTIVITIES

Virtual Tours

A Museum facilitator will present the exhibition with a video produced by the McCord Stewart Museum's Education, Community Engagement and Cultural Programs team. The video is presented from a Museum computer and accompanied by lively, interactive discussions between participants and the facilitator, creating a dynamic and engaging experience. Interaction is strongly encouraged to replicate the friendly, participatory atmosphere of an in-person guided tour. To ensure the activity runs smoothly, the group leader must be present: they must be either connected to the Zoom session or near the classroom computer so that they can intervene if needed.

Required Equipment

- A computer with Internet access, speakers, a microphone and ideally a webcam
- A projector if the activity takes place in a classroom

For the best experience, we recommend showing the video on a large screen (such as an interactive white board, large TV or projector screen).

Connection Instructions

The activity will take place on Zoom to encourage interaction between participants and our facilitators. Once your reservation is confirmed, you will receive detailed instructions on how to join the session. We strongly recommend reviewing these ahead of time to ensure a smooth and enjoyable experience for everyone.
