At the McCord Stewart Museum, we use objects, stories, and shared experiences to help our visitors better understand the world around them, no matter their age or background. With our participatory approach and civic perspective, we prioritize observation, questions, and dialogue in our activities.

#### TARGET AUDIENCES

- School daycare groups: Kindergarten (K5) – Elementary (all cycles)

#### DESCRIPTION

The Museum offers school daycare groups a day-long program designed to introduce young people to its exhibitions and collections, with an emphasis on Indigenous cultures. Activities include:

- Guided tour: *Indigenous Voices of Today: Knowledge, Trauma, Resilience* (all cycles)
- Workshop: Trickster (K5 and 1st cycle) or Tell Me a Legend (2nd and 3rd cycles)
- Guided tour: *On the Menu – Montreal: A Restaurant Story* (all cycles)
- Workshop: Menu Mash-up (all cycles)
